



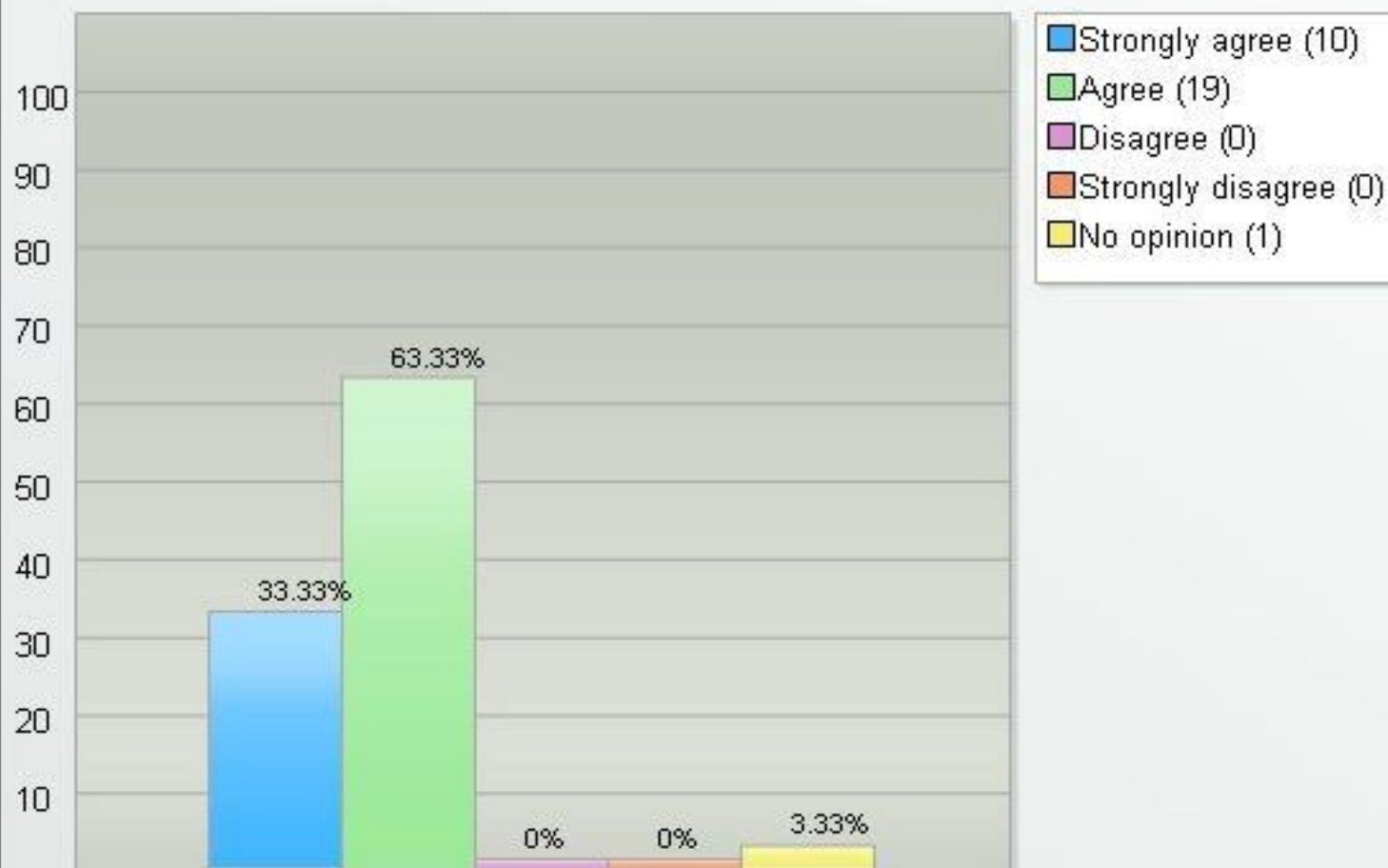

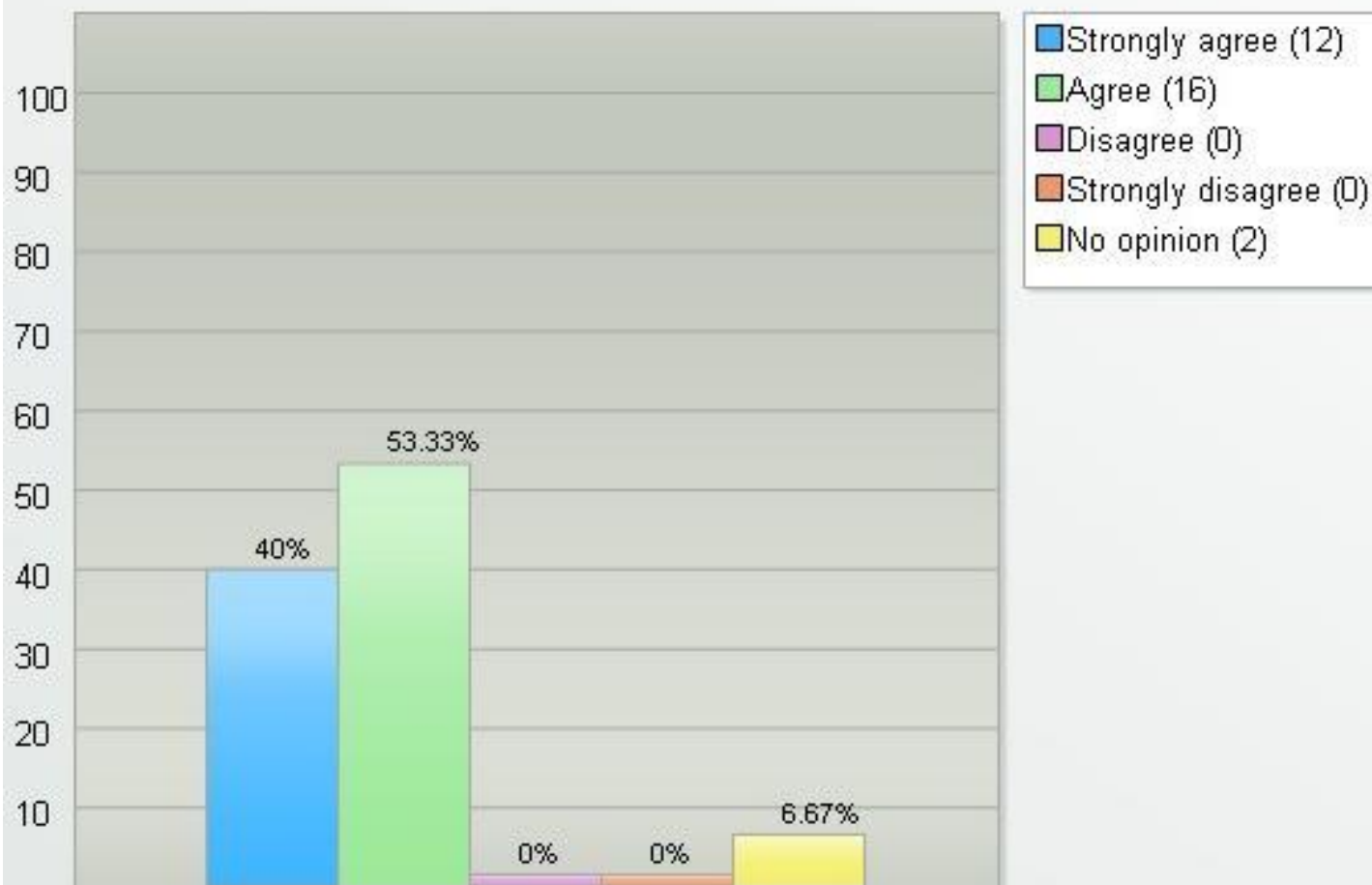
There is a greater respect for each other.

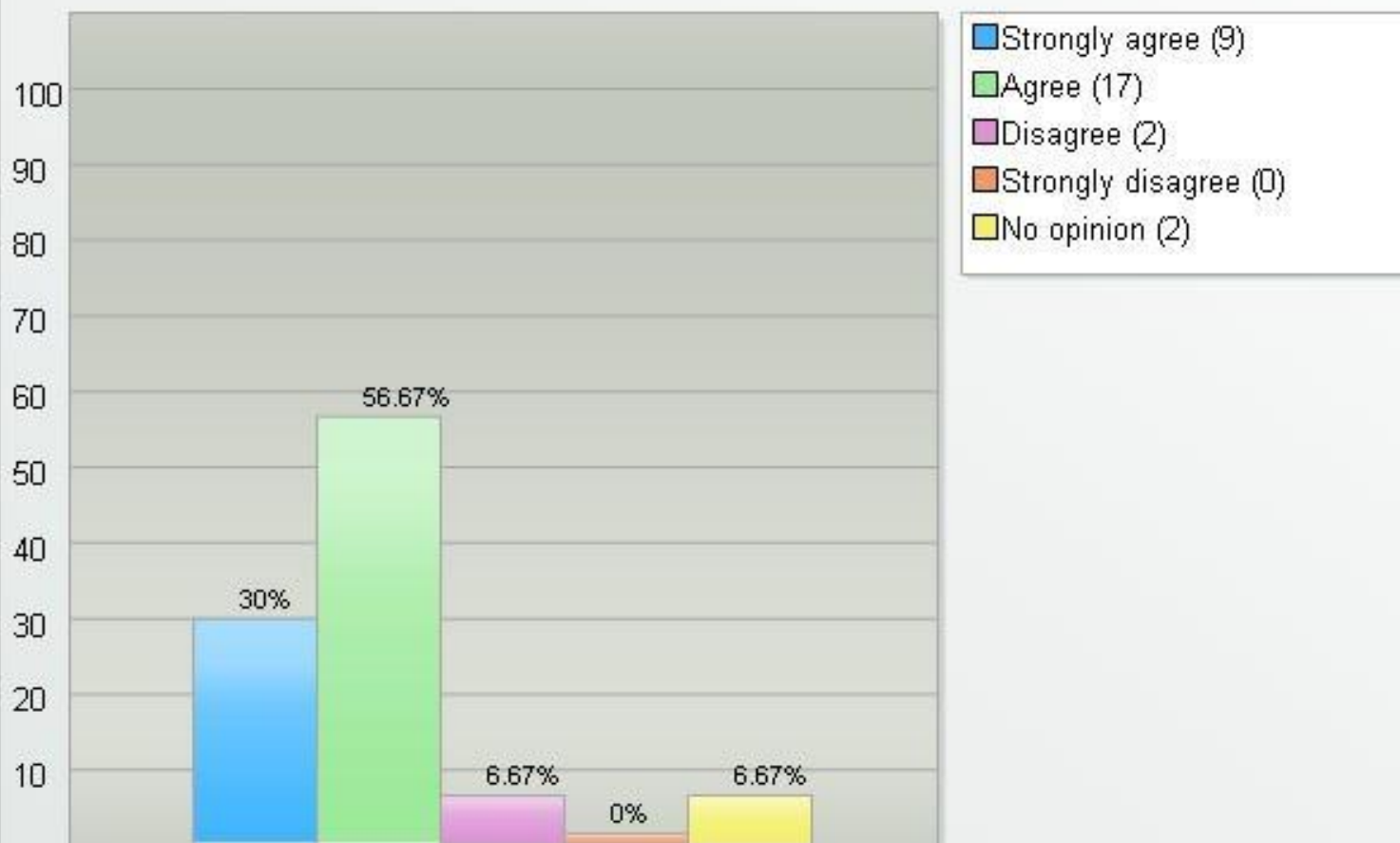
Children are more comfortable working in groups.

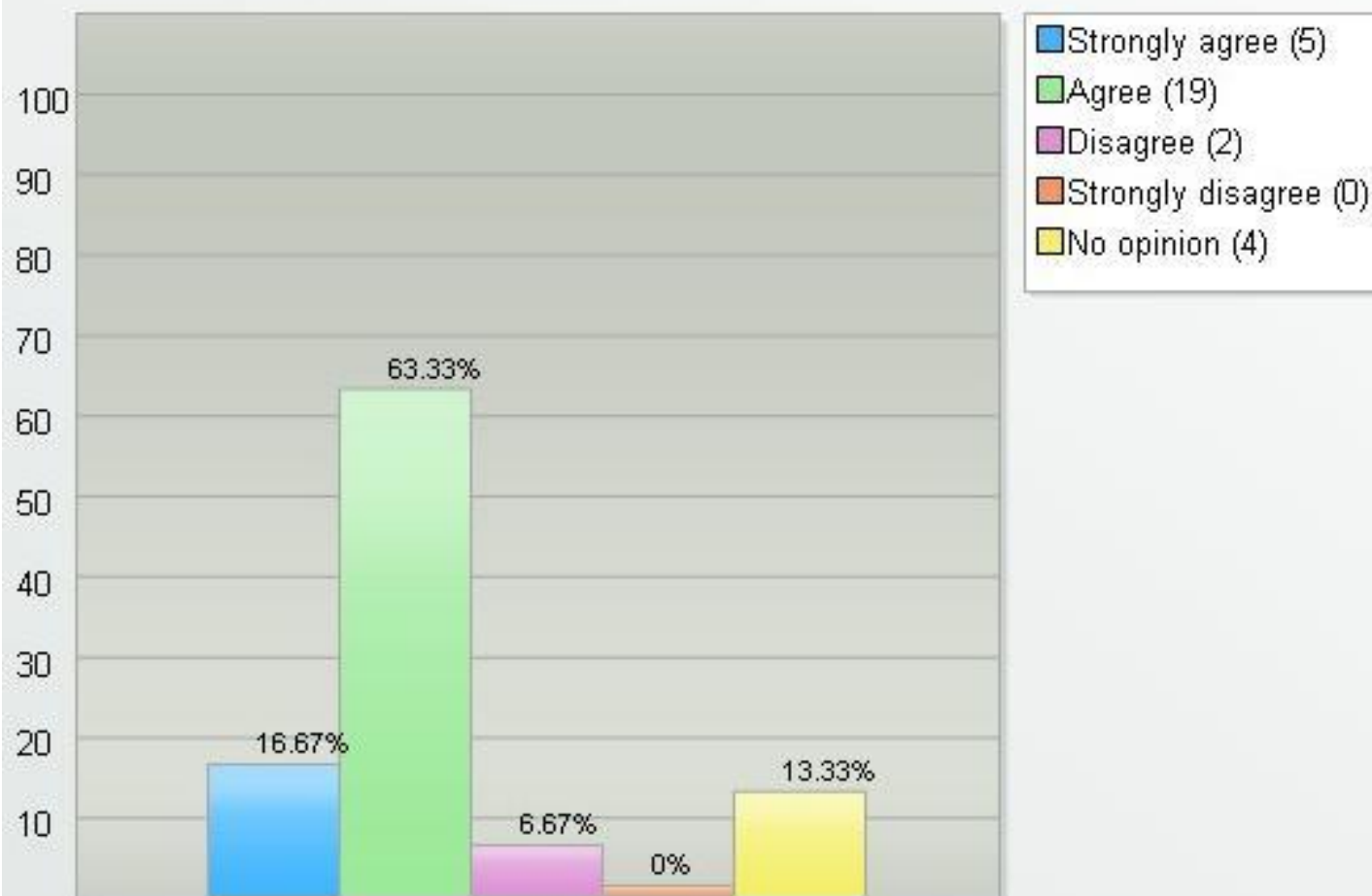
Children demonstrate good manners towards each oth...

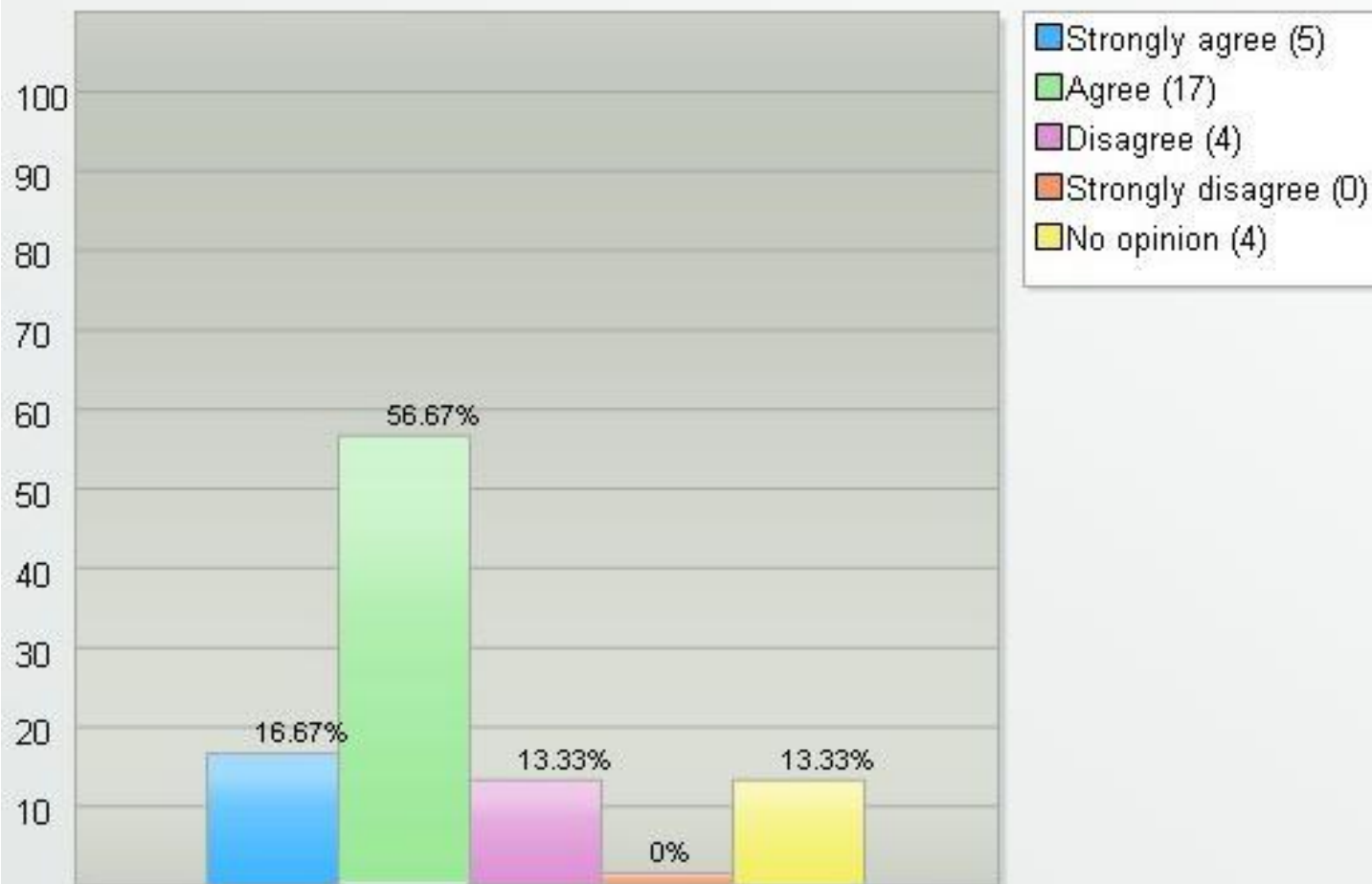
Children openly encourage and praise one another.

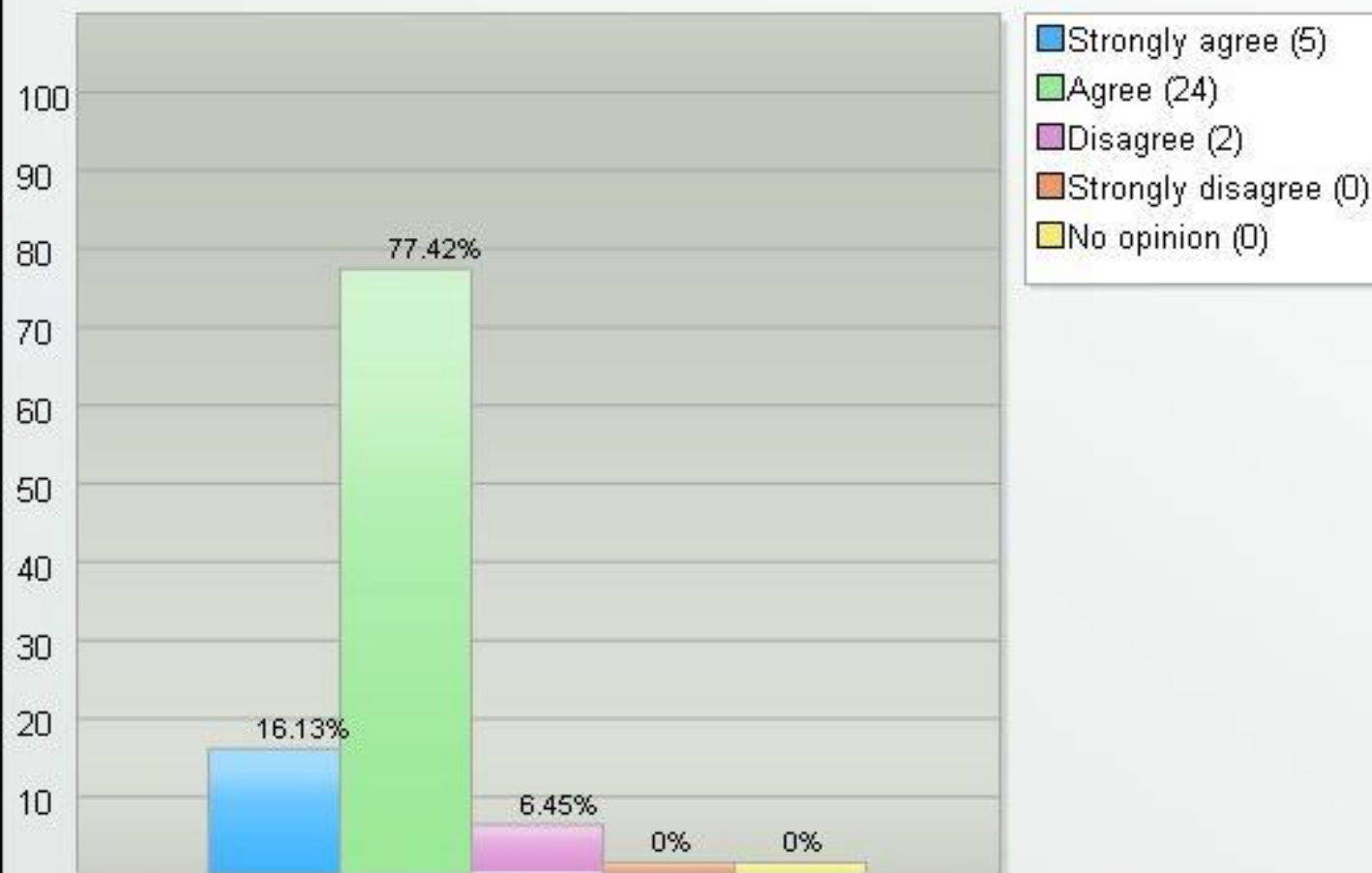
There is less bullying among children.

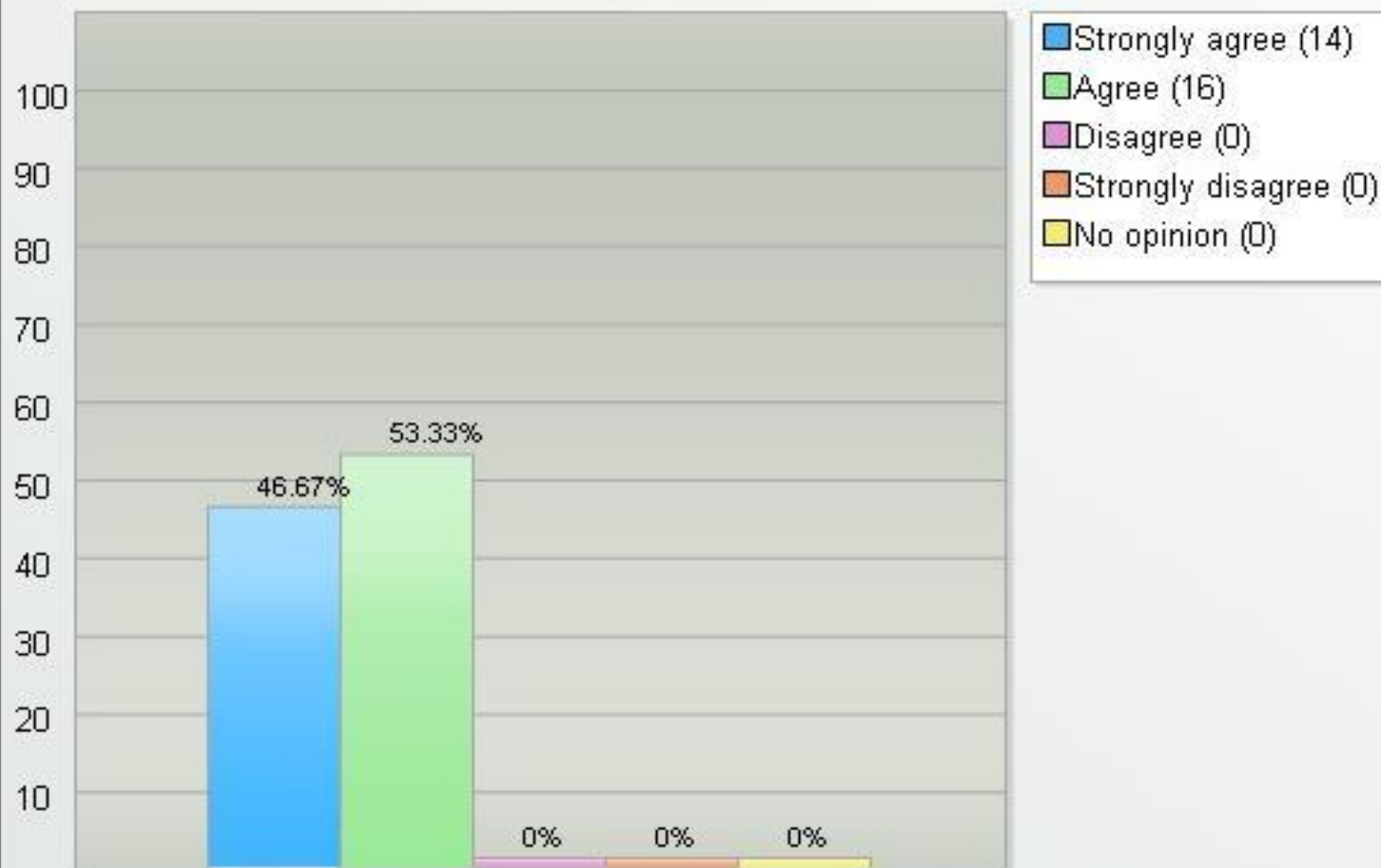
Self esteem has improved in general.
